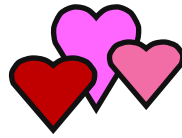

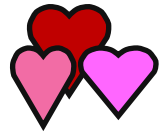

The Addison, Lois, and Betty Bowsby Agricultural Scholarship Fund was established in 2004 to provide one or more scholarships to Clarke County residents who are graduating from high school and who will be attending Iowa State University to study agriculture or an agricultural related field. Clarke County residents can also be attending Iowa State University and studying agriculture or an agricultural related field. The fund has a current market value of over \$38,000. There have been 12 scholarships totaling \$6,750 awarded from the fund.
